CORRALILLO WINEMAKER'S BLEND 2011



Description:

Corralillo Winemaker's Blend is bright red with violet hues. The nose displays expressive aromas of red fruit, chocolate and earthy spices. The palate is full and bold with soft tannins rounding it out. Each of the four grape varieties in the wine contribute different taste characteristics – the Syrah lends spice, as well as violets and damp soil; the Malbec adds floral and berry notes while the Cabernet Franc offers structure and tannins. The wood is perfectly integrated, contributing notes of chocolate and vanilla, topped off by a long-lasting, elegant and complex finish.

Winemaker's Notes:

The 2011 vintage brings together three varieties from the Matetic vineyards. Each varietal was processed separately and underwent a seven day cold soak maceration prior to fermentation. Each lot was aged for 15 months in French barrels from different coopers, forests and toast levels. Finally, the blend was carefully made, using specific percentages of each lot in order to achieve a balanced and complex wine.

Serving Hints:

This wine is ideally served with red meats and sharp cheeses, and hearty dishes like stews and roasts.
