

# TERRAPURA CHARDONNAY 2013



## Description:

This wine has a light yellow golden color, with delicate aromas of citrus and tropical fruits. It is fresh and round on the palate, with honey and citrus notes

## Winemaker's Notes:

The grapes for this single-vineyard wine come from Molina, located near the Andes Mountain in Curico Valley, situated around 125 mi (200 km) south of Santiago. The grapes are hand-picked at the end of March, crushed and undergo two hours of cold maceration, followed by pressing. Fermentation takes place at controlled temperatures of 55°-57°F (13-14°C) in stainless steel tanks over 25 days. The wine is aged in stainless steel tanks, with inner staves of French oak, for four months prior to bottling.

## Serving Hints:

Terrapura Chardonnay is perfect accompaniment to salads, soft cheeses, lightly-sauced pasta dishes and fish.
