

# TERRAPURA

## CHARDONNAY 2014



### Description:

This wine has a light golden color, with delicate aromas of citrus and tropical fruits. It is fresh and round on the palate, with honey and citric notes.

### Winemaker's Notes:

The grapes for this single-vineyard wine come from Molina area, close to the Andes Mountains in Curico Valley. These are hand-picked at the end of March, the grapes are crushed, and have two hours of cold maceration before going into the press. Fermentation takes place at controlled temperatures (55°F) in stainless steel tanks during twenty five days, where it is always protected from air contact.

### Interesting Fact:

Terrapura takes the Condor, Chile's national bird that lives in the valleys of the Andes, as its brand symbol. It appears on the label as a red Chilean Indian drawing, representing the strength and power of the Chilean terroir.

### Serving Hints:

Terrapura Chardonnay is perfect to accompany salads, soft cheeses, light-sauced pasta dishes and fish
