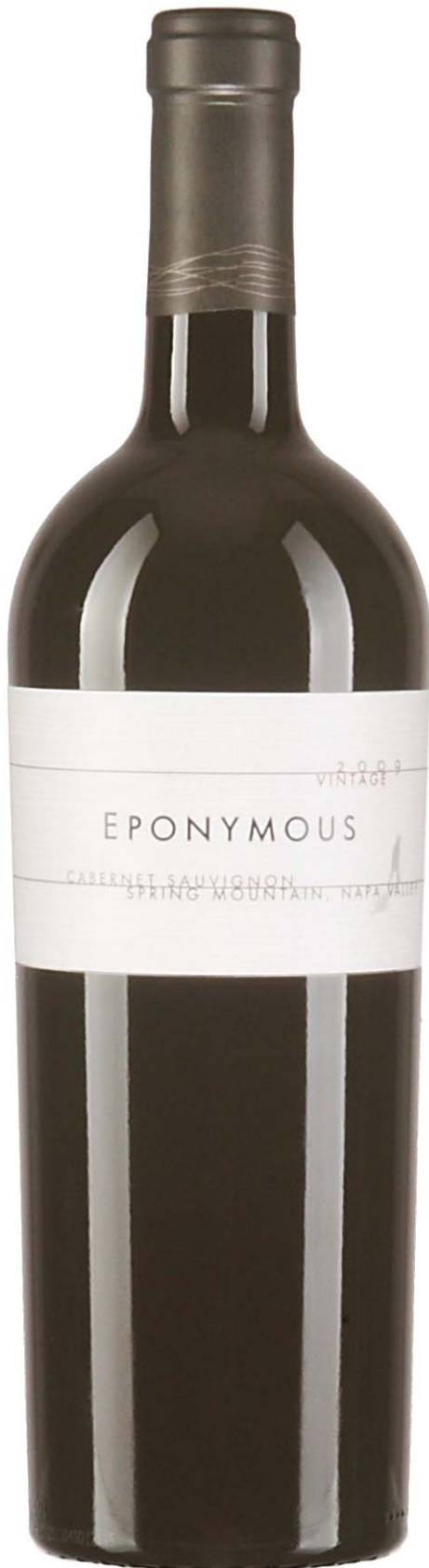


EPONYMOUS SPRING MOUNTAIN CABERNET 2012



Description:

Well integrated is an often overused descriptor, but in the case of this wine it is appropriate in the sense that even though there is wonderful intensity of aromas, there are so well married, that it is difficult to pick out individual characters. I find hints of dark fruit, eucalyptus, fennel, blackberry and mocha but these just scratch the surface of the scents emanating from the glass. These aromas carry over nicely to the flavors on the palate, with added hints of currants and ripe pomegranates. Bold, rich mouth feel on this big bodied wine carry from the entry to the finish, with restrained tannins that should lead to long aging potential as well as current enjoyment.

Winemaker's Notes:

This Cabernet Sauvignon is our fourth vintage from the highly regarded Spring Mountain Appellation. The wonderful 2012 harvest was marked by a long growing season, allowing for long hang time, which along with moderate heat, aided in even maturation. There was an absence of any cool wet weather. This even, slow maturation produced balanced morphologically ripe fruit at moderate sugar levels.

Serve at room temperature with red meats, lamb, cheeses.
