Description:

This wine is a fine expression of its terroir with aromas of Morello Cherries, plums, hints of pepper and is garnet in color. This wellstructured Juliénas reveals virile, mentholated tannins that will mellow with time.

Winemaker's Notes:

The vines are 45 years old on average and face south-south-east. Thierry Condemine uses responsible growing methods with minimum spraying and the grapes are picked by hand. After traditional vinification, the wine is matured in large barrels for seven to eight months until it is bottled.

Serving Hints:

This wine pairs nicely with steak, green pepper sauce and mature cheeses.

Interesting Fact:

In the 13th century, on the site of the current chateau, a stronghold was built which belonged to the Lord of Beaujeu. The building was altered several times over the centuries.
