**DESCRIPTION**

The nose has tinges of violets and is fruity. On the palate, there are notes of blackberries, spices and a bit of tobacco. The Pascual Toso Alta Malbec 2018 has a rich and long finish.

**WINEMAKER NOTES**

The grapes for this wine come from 60-year-old vines. The soil is frank and stony. The grapes are hand-picked. Cold maceration takes place before fermentation for 48 hours. The winemaking process is carried out in stainless-steel tanks and macerated for 15-20 days. The wine is softly filtered before being bottled. The wine is aged in new French oak barrels for 14 months. Once bottled, the wine remains for 6 months in the winery's temperature-controlled cellar.

**SERVING HINTS**

Suggested serving temperature of 59 – 60.8 F

This Malbec is best enjoyed with red meats such as juicy grilled steaks, red-sauce pasta dishes and mature cheeses.
