



Description:

The 2015 Pillar Box Red has lively aromas of blackcurrant, mint and licorice. The palate has concentrated mulberry, mocha and cinnamon flavors, fine tannins and a fresh minty finish.

Winemaker's Notes:

The fruit for this wine was sourced from the Henry's Drive Padthaway vineyards. These vines are grown in various soil types including red loam, black loam & deep sand over limestone. Each vineyard destined for the Pillar Box range of wines is harvested at ideal ripeness and then fermented on skins for approximately five days. The free run and pressings are separated and all parcels are kept separate throughout the vinification process until the final blend is determined, just prior to bottling. The wines are matured for a period of 18 months and 30% of the wine is matured with oak (90% French and 10% American).

Serving Hints:

This wine matches well with pizza or braised short ribs.

Interesting Fact:

In honor of the Tenth Vintage of Pillar Box Red, owner Kim Longbottom has added to the well-known red Pillar Box label (which symbolizes a mailbox in rural Australia and Great Britain). A bold Roman Numeral "number ten" in shiny silver is on top right side of the label, with copy inside it that explains that 2015 is the wine's tenth year.
