

LEAPING HORSE CHARDONNAY 2014



Description:

Medium bodied, with a pale yellow hue, the 2014 Leaping Horse Chardonnay is bright and crisp, from start to finish. It has citrus highlights to green apple and tropical fruit aromas and flavors. The finish shows a bit of lemon zest and a tight minerality that is refreshing and enjoyable.

Winemaker's Notes:

Ironstone practices sustainable viticultural such as crop reduction, leaf removal, organic materials and drip irrigation to improve the quality of the grapes and intensity of flavors. Cover crops, which attract beneficial insects, are also employed, as well as the placement of owl and wood duck boxes around the vineyards and ponds to help preserve the surrounding habitats. The wine spends two months' aging in new French oak.

Serving Hints:

This Chardonnay should be served chilled on-its-own or paired with a variety of cuisines and dishes, such as vegetarian pastas, herb-roasted chicken, grilled salmon and many other seafood or shellfish dishes, especially those in cream sauces.
