3 RINGS SHIRAZ 2014







Description:

Rich, dense and intense with a mulberry to ink like hue. A subtle and sophisticated nose, leads to a powerful palate of ripe black cherries, the darkest and richest chocolate integrated with ripe dark juicy plum flesh, traces of freshly ground coffee beans with hints of black olive, peat and anise seed. Textual, well-balanced with mildly smooth tannins leading to a powerful but harmonious finish.

Winemaker's Notes:

The 2014 Barossa vintage will go down as a testament to the ability of both grapes and people to thrive under a challenge. Even late in the season vines were green, fresh and healthy, ripening the late varieties well into autumn. Good winter and early spring rains filled the soils and set the vines up well for the season. July to September rainfall was 20% above average. Late spring and summer were dry and warem at least during the days, with significant heat records being set. Generally lower than average crops were reported across the Barossa and Eden Valley. Reds are rich and varietal, with dense colors, plenty of fruit weight from the start, middle and the finish. Ensuring this vintage will be very age worthy wines.

Serving Hints:

Slow cooked brisket, grilled lamb, grass feed beef or a hearty beef stew and, of course, steak.
