

PILLAR BOX

RESERVE CABERNET 2010



Description:

The Reserve Cabernet has berry and cherry aromas, along with dusty cocoa, warm spices and hints of spearmint. An attractive and true varietal expression of Cabernet Sauvignon from Padthaway. The palate begins with dark berry fruit and earthy tobacco leaf characters which are layered over cedar spice and leathery tones. Subtle oak gives complexity and the wine is well structured and has smooth and fine tannins.

Winemaker's Notes:

Each vineyard destined for the Pillar Box range of wines is harvested when the grape flavor is ripe, then fermented on skins for around five days. The free run and pressings fractions are separated and all parcels are kept separate throughout the vinification process. The wines are matured for a period of 12 months, 30% of the volume with oak; using 90% French and 10% American oak. The vines are grown in either red and black loam, both over a limestone base.

Serving Hints:

This wine is a great accompaniment to hearty meat dishes, such as lamb shanks or just a nice steak.
