TERRAPURA CHARDONNAY 2015



Description:

Exhibiting a light golden color, this wine presents delicate citrus and tropical fruit aromas. It is fresh and round on the palate, with honey and citric notes.

Winemaker's Notes:

The grapes for this single-vineyard wine come from the Molina area, close to the Andes Mountains in Curico Valley. Handpicked at the end of March, the grapes are crushed, and undergo two hours of cold maceration at 46.4° C. Fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks for 25 days at controlled temperatures (55-57° F).

Interesting Fact:

Terrapura takes the Condor, Chile's national bird that lives in the valleys of the Andes, as its brand symbol. It appears on the label as a red Chilean Indian drawing, representing the strength and power of the Chilean terroir.

Serving Hints:

Terrapura Chardonnay is perfect to accompany salads, soft cheeses, light-sauced pasta dishes and fish.
