Don Juan Megia Sanchez founded the winery in 1904. It began as a small family affair that has been since, passed down from generation to generation. In 1989 the winery was acquired by and is currently run by president Doroteo Navarro Doñada and his three children.

The vineyards encompasses 427 acres, of which, 370 are exclusively dedicated to Tempranillo. The high-tech facilities have stainless steel vats, a microfiltration room, automated production lines and laboratory with the best technology available. The winery stands out in the industry for controlling temperature and moisture throughout the entire year.
