Gustave Lorentz, based in the village of Bergheim, in central Alsace, is family owned and managed by president George Lorentz. The winery has been in existence since 1836 and has been passed down from father to son, now in it's sixth generation.

All 85 acres are harvested exclusively by hand, and in 2012 became certified organic with 'Ecocert'.
