

The Cortonesi family owns La Mannella vineyards which covers a surface of 138 acres, 20 of which especially devoted to the production of Brunello di Montalcino. The vineyards are located in one of the most valuable areas of the region, both north and south-east of Montalcino. The Cortonesi family works according to tradition, yet employs modern winemaking techniques that help enhance the quality of their wines.





- La Manella Brunello di Montalcino is from the Montalcino region in Tuscany.
- The family farm is especially devoted to the production of this wine.
- The soil type is rocky with favorable exposure with lots of sun.
- The vineyard trellis system is spurred cordon and the winemaking style follows tradition.
- The Farm has also two apartments, in the "Poggiarelli" area, available for lodging purposes.













The wine is aged in oak for three years and an additional six months in the bottle prior to release.
