“The Luca Bosio 2017 Barbaresco is an expressive red wine that shows a full chorus of aromas, ranging from black fruit to crushed limestone and spicy sweet oak. The wine is fermented in steel vats and ages in botte. It offers a 360-degree approach to Nebbiolo and focuses on the broad brushstrokes, more than it does the tiny details. Those sweeping aromas represent a common trait in wines from this hot and dry vintage.”
