Shows very good energy and insistent floral character on the persistent, subtly tannic finish, which leaves sweet red fruit preserve and smoky mineral notes behind."

"Dried cherries with some flowers on the nose, following through to a medium body with menthol, bark and dried tea. Subtle and complex. From 60-year-old vines. Drink or hold."
