“This big, burly effort is structured and solidly textured. It has weight accompanying the blackberry flavor, with a firm character that demands aging over at least 18 months. The finish is still firm and concentrated.”

“The 2015 Morgon Domaine de Mont Chavy (a tank sample) comes from a vineyard owned by Frank and Laurent Chavy. It has plenty of blueberry jam and cassis scents on the nose, which becomes quite floral in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with sweet dark cherry fruit, boysenberry and a lovely spicy/white pepper note sprinkled over the finish. This has very good potential.

“Deep ruby. Dark berries, licorice and candied flowers on the perfumed nose, with a smoky mineral nuance that builds in the glass. Gently sweet dark berry, cherry and fruitcake flavors are braced by juicy acidity and pick up a spicy element on the back half. Closes smoky and long, with building tannins and a lingering hint of bitter cherry.”

“The 2014 Morgon Domaine Mont Chavy was cropped at 45 hectoliters per hectare this year. It has a precise red cherry and bergamot-scented nose that unfurls in the glass. The palate is juicy and quite dense – thick tannin shrouded in lightly spiced redcurrant and blackcurrant fruit that lead to a sharp, nicely focused finish that demonstrates fine backbone. This is probably the best from Georges Duboeuf this year. Very fine.!”
