



RESERVA CABERNET "Highlights"

2018

• 91 – VINOUS, Oct. 21, 2021

"A Cabernet Sauvignon from Barrancas aged for 12 months in 80% American oak, one-third of it new. Garnet red in the glass. The nose features roasted red pepper, caramel and kirsch; cherry and blackberry heighten the complexity. Flavorful and voluminous in the mouth, with fine-grained tannins and good body. A chewy wine with a bold, lasting finish."

2017

• 90 – WINE ADVOCATE, Oct. 31, 2019

"The leafy and varietal 2017 Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon had fruit in the foreground and the oak was neatly folded into the fruit coming through as harmonious and elegant, not terribly complex, quite fruit driven but nicely balanced and fresh and with a tasty finish."

"The attractive plum cake and spice character is married to a medium-full body and rather polished tannins. With a bit more freshness this would rate higher. Drink now."

"A solid and rich red with firm and chewy tannins. Full-bodied, tight and lightly austere. long and structured. Needs two or three years to open."

"Aromas of tar and rubber give way to rich black fruits and toasty oak. A hard, tannic palate means this needs air or meaty foods. Oaky, resiny berry and cassis flavors finish chocolaty, with intense tannins. Drink through 2021."

"Classical and proportioned, the 2014 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon was distinctly varietal with very good freshness and the classical tobacco leaf and blackberry aromas coupled with very fine tannins and great acidity. Impressive."

"The 2012 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is slightly backward with reserved aromas of black fruit, exotic spicy notes of smoked paprika, pink pepper, very fine tannins and good acidity, which will make it very good at the table at a great price. Drink now-2016."
