RESERVA MALBEC "Highlights"

2018

- **90 – VINOUS**, *October 21, 2020*

"A Malbec from Barrancas aged for 12 months in one-third new, 80% American barrels. Bright purple in color. The nose presents blackberry and plum jam with pencil box notes and sprinkling of spices. Voluminous on the palate, displaying a slightly rugged texture that clings to the gums and oak tannins that lend structure before the flavorful finish."

2017

- **91 – WINE ADVOCATE**, *October 31, 2019*

"The elegant and balanced 2017 Reserva Malbec showed the hand of a skilled winemaker. It had a traditional profile with enough ripeness and very integrated oak focused, clean and varietal (violets, red cherries) with very good freshness. The palate was very balanced with super fine tannins very good freshness. Really impressive."

2016

- **90 – WINE ADVOCATE**, *June 29, 2018*

"This is a solid red with a dense and chewy texture. full-bodied, layered and rich. tight focused. Very pretty. Drink now or hold."

2015

- **92 – JAMES SUCKLING**, *June 21, 2017*

"This is a solid red with a dense and chewy texture. full-bodied, layered and rich. tight focused. Very pretty. Drink now or hold."

- **90 – WINE SPECTATOR**, *March 31, 2018*

"Elegant and richly textured, with a silky mouthfeel and plush flavors of cheery, plum and mocha. Chocolate notes linger on the well-spiced finish, revealing hints of slate."

2014

- **90 Pts. – WINE ENTHUSIAST**, *July 2017*

This opens with mostly toast and barrel char, but airing allows chocolate and spice aromas into play. This Malbec feels tight, stout and chewy, with fresh acidity and firm tannins. Black-fruit flavors are toasty all the way to a peppery spicy finish. Drink through 2021

- **90 Pts. – JAMES SUCKLING**, *May 23, 2016*

"A decadent and rich wine with sliced raw meat and dark fruits. Full body, velvety tannins and lots of ripe, lightly dried fruits. Juicy finish. Old style but I like it this year. Drink now."

"Classical and proportioned, the 2014 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon was distinctly varietal with very good freshness and the classical tobacco leaf and blackberry aromas coupled with very fine tannins and great acidity. Impressive."
