Give this wine time in glass to show off its layers of aromas: beet root, mocha, plum, currant and licorice, with dried mint and tobacco leaf underneath. The palate brings a burst of juicy, plump fruit, toasty, somewhat flashy oak, spice and fine, structured tannins.”
