"Cedary up front, with an appealing layer of smoke and spice to the bright, supple and ripe cherry and raspberry fruit flavors. Notes of tobacco and clove gain presence on the finish. Drink now."

"Plush and expressive, with juicy black cherry, dark plum and roasted meat flavors that combine smoothly on the long finish. Has depth and persistence. Drink now through 2020."
