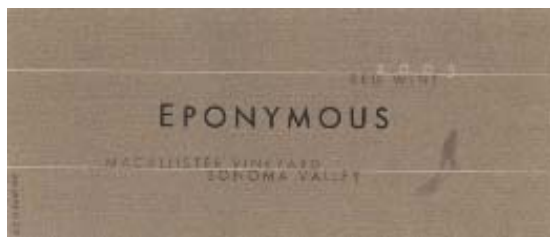


# Eponymous MacAllister Red Wine
