## “Highlights”

### 2014

“Green-tinged straw. Vibrant, high-pitched aromas of fresh grapefruit and lime, with a subtle floral overtone. Racy and sharply focused, offering an array of fresh citrus and orchard fruit flavors and strong spicy lift. Finishes taut and dry, with resonating citrus fruit character and good clarity.”
