## “Highlights”

### 2015

“...There is a clear step up in complexity and depth compared with the Corralillo and also more freshness, from a vineyard that has contained yields and has more influence from the sea. This is simply delicious, with notes of sour cherries, a spicy twist and a focused and delineated palate from the shallow granite soils.”

“Very bright and flamboyant aromas of crushed raspberry and blueberry. Hints of spice. Medium to full body, fine tannins and a fruity, savory character. Whole berry and 25% stems in fermentation and maceration. Fruit-forward in a subtle way. Drink now. Made from biodynamic grapes.”

“...The 2014 is a lot darker than the 2013, and it also feels riper and rounder, with a richer texture but keeping the austere profile of sour cherries, as well as the freshness and minerality provided the granite...”

### 2013

“...This is the vineyard that is closest to the sea where the soils are decomposed granite with minerals like mica and iron. The grapes are destemmed but not crushed, and in this 2013 they used a small percentage of full clusters (around 20%); it underwent a cold soak without SO<sub>2</sub> for seven days after which the temperature was left to rise and fermentation starts. They do punching down, as they want a soft extraction. Malolactic is in barrel, where the wine matures for 14 months with only one racking...”
