"A Bordeaux-style blend of 41% Cabernet
Sauvignon, 35% Malbec, 15% Merlot and 9% Petit
Verdot that spent 14 months aging in French
barrels, Enzo is part of a legacy of premium
Argentine wines that have defined the segment in
the country since the 1990s. With a ripe profile of
blackberry and black currant and hints of jam
sprinkled with sweet spices, black pepper,
sandalwood and cedar, the aging process is key to
this wine. Layer follows upon layer but each ends
with herbal traces. Intense in the mouth, with
active, juicy tannins and a lingering, moderate,
packaged freshness, this is a sun-kissed wine that
manages to be fluid and concentrated at the same
time."
