2019

•90 – **VINOUS**, *October 21, 2020*

"A Malbec from Mendoza, 30% aged for eight months in used oak. Bright purple in huge. The well-defined fruity aromas include fresh plum and cherry, plus hints of blood and white pepper. Flavorsome and succinct with moderate freshness, it flows free and smooth, the aging process showing at the back of the mouth. Fruity, pleasant finish."

•91 – **JAMES SUCKLING**, *April 2, 2020*

"Medium-bodied red with cranberry and blueberry flavors, as well as grapey and floral notes. Fruity and easy at the end. Drink now."

2018

•92 – **JAMES SUCKLING**, *April 2, 2020*

"An attractive, balanced red with blueberry and light hazelnut character, as well as chocolate. Medium-bodied, fresh and vivid. Drink or hold."

2017

•90 – **JAMES SUCKLING**, *March 27, 2019*

"An array of toasted spice aromas are dusted across tarry dark-fruit notes that follow to the palate where smooth, ripe and easygoing style prevails. Drink or hold."

2014

•90 – **WINE SPECTATOR**, *March 31, 2016*

"A rich and well-spiced style, with concentrated flavors of dark plum, dark cherry and dried raspberry. This is loaded with chocolate and smoke notes that linger on the finish. Drink now through 2020."

2011

•89 – **WINE ENTHUSIAST**, *May 1, 2014*

"Dark berry and lemony oak lead the aromas on this barrel-driven Malbec. In the mouth, it's resinous and creamy, while blackberry and woody flavors yield to café mocha. A resinous finish is loaded with overt oak character."

2010

•90 – **WINE ADVOCATE**, *Dec. 2011*

"The 2010 Famiglia Bianchi Malbec was made with organically grown grapes. Balsam wood, mineral, brier, cherry blossom, and assorted black fruits titillate the nose while pointing to a full-bodied, structured, savory wine with layers of spicy black fruit flavors. Balanced and lengthy..."
