DESCRIPTION

This wine has an intense ruby-red color, with aromas of red fruits, blueberries, and plums – with an elegant floral touch. The palate is smooth, with rounded tannins and good volume – accompanied by a pleasant touch of oak. The wine ends up with a long and lingering finish.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The grapes for this wine come from Colchagua Valley. Hand-picked from the end of April to the beginning of May, the grapes are crushed, and undergo 5 days of cold maceration (50° F). fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks takes place at controlled temperatures (82°F) during ten days. The wine was then aged in contact with French and American oak for 6 months.

INTERESTING FACT

The TerraPura illustration on the label seeks to convey the importance of maintaining the ecosystem in which humans, plants and animals coexist. The trumpets/speakers at the apex of the illustration represent the importance of listening to what nature has to tell us.
