DESCRIPTION

This Cabernet is a very attractive ruby color. Spicy aromas such as red bell pepper, black peppercorn, and notes of ripe red fruits (all of which are typical of this varietal when grown in San Rafael). The soil provides some mineral notes which add freshness to this vivacious wine.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The grapes come from family vineyards as well as from associated producers in San Rafael. At 820.21 yards above sea level. The Bianchi vineyards – Finca Dona Elsa and elsewhere within the district – are grown on sandy, calcareous soil of alluvial origin. These poor soils, with a loamy-sandy texture, have some calcareous sediment, which provides mineral notes in the wine.

INTERESTING FACTS

Elsa Bianchi wines are named after Dona Elsa, the late grandmother of the current Bianchi owners, who started the winery with her husband. Her first home, a small “Casa” still sits among the vineyards that also bear her name
