DESCRIPTION

The 2020 vintage is a medium shade of orange, with an intense nose full of strawberry, raspberry and vine peach, as well as flowers, and a touch of orange blossom. On the palate, the wine is balanced and lively, with fresh fruit flavors and pronounced aromatic persistence.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Maison Bouey's Merlot vineyards are within the Bordeaux Red Appellation, a very large geographical area with a great diversity of soils and terroirs.

2020 was an interesting vintage for Bordeaux's vineyards, with a beautiful summer that allowed for good maturity and perfect conditions for the harvest. A combination of modern and traditional winemaking techniques were employed, with the wine fermented in stainless steel vats to preserve the fruit characters.

INTERESTING FACT

Pantone, the most famous colorists in the world, began their first and only partnership in the wine industry with Maison Bouey. This unique cobranding encourages the buyer to choose Famille Bouey's Rose based on its color (in the case of the 2020 vintage, it is Pantone 721).

SERVING HINTS

Ideal as an aperitif, this wine is also excellent with grilled veal, salmon temaki, or feta cheese and cherry tomato tart. For dessert, it pairs well with a peach and pomegranate Pavlova.
