DESCRIPTION

This wine blends Sauvignon Blanc grapes from two of the winery's estate vineyards. The cooler Los Alamos Vineyard (originally planted from cuttings brought over from Europe 40 years ago), provides crispness, while the warmer Valley View Vineyard fruit brings the tropical guava and pineapple aromas, with flavors of juicy white peaches and Meyer lemons that linger on the stunning finish.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The vineyards of Lucas & Lewellen are located in the three principal wine grape growing regions of Santa Barbara County: Santa Maria Valley; Los Alamos Valley; and Santa Ynez Valley. These valley vineyards benefit from a transverse mountain range topography, and an east-west orientation that channels cool ocean air from the Pacific into the coastal valleys. Warm days and cool nights produce a long and gentle growing season.

SERVING HINTS

Serve chilled with salmon, lobster, poultry and salads as well as sushi.
