GEORGES DUBOEUF 'FLOWER LABEL' SAINT-VÉRAN 2017



Description:

This Flower Label Saint-Véran is made entirely of the Chardonnay grape from the Mâconnais region of France. It has a shiny pale color, and a complex nose of peach, white flowers, citrus, and a touch of minerality. Fresh and vivid, with length on the palate.

Winemaker's Notes:

From vines over 20 years old. Guyot Trellis System. Pressing, juice racking, temperature control during the entire process, alcoholic fermentation and storage in stainless steel vats (100% maloactic).

Serving Hints:

This white wine is great with seafood, grilled shrimp salad, or with a variety of appetizers.

Interesting Fact:

The appellation spreads across 7 production communes: Chânes, Chasselas, Davayé, Leynes, Fuissé, Saint Vérand et Solutré-Pouilly. The soil, the relief, the grape variety and the vinification technique offer points in common certainly, but SAINT-VERAN has its own originality as far as taste is concerned.
