Wine Composition

DESCRIPTION

Famiglia Bianchi Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 offers a deep red color, with an attractive ruby hue. Red bell peppers and black peppercorns stand out among the complex spices that fill the nose. Notes of berries and minerality are in the background. Together with the vanilla and chocolate notes from its ageing in French oak, this wine achieves a nice complexity of aromas with a remarkable fruit-wood balance. It is harmonious on the palate, with balanced acidity, juicy tannins, and a persistent finish.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The grapes for this Cabernet Sauvignon come from both the Uco Valley, and three different vinevards in San Rafael: Finca Dona Elsa. Finca Asti, and Finca Costanza. Each is in a different micro-climate with different soils, which provides an interesting complexity for both the wine's aromas as well as its flavors. The soils are of alluvial origin, some with large numbers of rocks, and others containing calcareous sediment that provides mineral elements to the wine. Altitude is a distinctive feature of the grapes for this wine. with vineyards at approximately 4,265 feet above sea level. The extensive thermal amplitude results in wines with good structure and complexity. Twenty percent of the wine is aged for eight months in French Oak barrels.

SERVING HINTS

Serve at room temperature with red meats, lamb, cheeses.
