



Description:

The 2017 L10 Malbec is red with violet hues, typical of the Malbec grape. In the nose, there are ripe, purple plums, with hints of vanilla. There is a smooth mouthfeel, with flavors of ripe berries, raspberries and soft toast. It has roundness and harmony, all the way through the pleasant finish. This wine is marked with personality, boasting the noble features of the varietal.

Winemaker's Notes:

L10 Malbec comes from vineyards located in San Rafael, Mendoza, at 750 meters above sea level, on sandy, calcareous soil of alluvial origins. The grapes were hand-picked and classically fermented, including one weeks' maceration on the skins and periodic pumpover. Fermentation temperatures were controlled, never exceeding 28°C. The wine spends three months in bottle, prior to release.

Serving Hints:

This wine is ideal to serve with a large variety of foods, especially with meat and hard cheeses.
