

TWO ANGELS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2016



Description:

This fruit-forward wine shows great intensity as it is poured into the glass, with hints of grapefruit, pear, honeysuckle, and citrus blossoms to name a few. A little sur lies aging adds a little weight to the mid-palate without sacrificing the refreshing crispness from entry to long, lingering finish. Added flavors of honeydew melon and mineral notes are evident on the palate.

Winemaker's Notes:

Two Angels Sauvignon Blanc once again features fruit only from the High Valley Appellation in Lake County. These High Valley vineyards boast extremely volcanic, red pumice stone terroir. At close to 2100 feet, the area is reminiscent of the Rhone's Valley's Crozes-Hermitage vineyards.

Interesting Fact:

The label art was created by Jacob de Backer in 1591. The theme of the piece is the hilarity of inebriation and the trauma of the morning after. Excessive joy must be countered by equally excessive sorrow, with penitential atonement for pleasure (the first "Drink Responsibly" print campaign).

Serving Hints:

Serve slightly chilled, a great accompaniment to fish, shellfish and pasta.
