DESCRIPTION

The 2020 Maçon-Village leads off with a shiny pale gold color and an intensely fruity, fresh and aromatic nose. White flowers and citrus fruit predominate, and continue through the palate. This wine presents a lot of charm, with a round and supple mouthfeel, leading to a fresh, lingering finish.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

After a careful selection of grapes from small parcels in the region (from vines over 20 years old), they are gently pressed and racked. The juice undergoes 100 percent malolactic fermentation in stainless steel vats. The resulting wine is bottled and shipped soon after harvest, to retain its freshness.

SERVING HINTS

Best paired with appetizers, fish tacos, shrimp ceviche or goat cheese salad.

INTERESTING FACT

Within a natural isosceles triangle formed by Mâcon, the noble Chardonnay grape reigns a monarch due to the chalk-rich soil. This is the southern part of the world-famous province of Burgundy, with its gently rolling hills and lush vineyards, so dear to the French romantic poet and statesman, Lamartine. The author, born in Mâcon, spent his youth in the picture book Mâconnais wine village of Milly. It was his love for the young and pretty Elvire that triggered his literary career. During his extremely active life, Lamartine devoted his energies to his dual vocations of poet and political figure. The white wines known as Mâcon-Villages come from some 40 different villages that lie to the north and west of Mâcon and the tranquil Saone River. The native chardonnay grapes produce lively and delicate wines overflowing with charm.
