DESCRIPTION

The 2017 Henry's Drive Magnus Shiraz has a complex aroma spectrum of lavender, thyme and star anise. The palate is packed with dark brooding fruits entwined with blackberry, dark chocolate and licorice. A beautifully balanced wine supported by seamless French oak and fine-grained tannins.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The majority of the fruit for Magnus Shiraz is sourced from a unique site in Padthaway. Harvested in mid-March, it undergoes initial fermentation in open fermenters whilst being held on skins for 3 weeks and hand-plunged daily. It is then transferred to French oak barrels for malolactic fermentation and is matured for twenty-two months in new, fine grained, medium toast puncheons.

SERVING HINTS

Magnus benefits from decanting at least one hour before serving and is best paired with Beef Wellington or Venison Sausage Cassoulet.
