DESCRIPTION

Intense deep red color with violet flashes. Strong and spicy aromas including red and black pepper, accompanied by hints of red fruits, mineral notes, and both vanilla and chocolate. On the palate, there is a fine balance between spices, red fruits, and oak notes. It has a firm structure, with balanced acidity, elegant and juicy tannins, very good volume, structure, and persistence at the end.

WINEMAKER NOTES

This is a Cabernet Sauvignon blend of different terroirs from San Rafael. The grapes come from three different vineyards: Finca Dona Elsa, located in Rama Caida district; Finca Asti, from Las Paredes district, and Finca Constanza, located in Cuadro Begegas district. The soils are of variable composition and diverse microclimates, which leads to complex aromas and flavors. Picked by hand, the grapes went through classical crushing and fermentation, with periodic pump-over and maceration on skins for 21 days. 50% of the wine was aged for eight months in French Oak barrels. The remaining 50% was left in stainless-steel temperature-controlled vats for 8 months. After stabilization, filtering and bottling, the final wine was bottle-aged an additional four months.

Serve at room temperature with red meats, lamb, cheeses.
