Description:

Considered the most sensual of all Cru Beaujolais, the 2016 Saint-Amour is full-bodied and voluptuous with aromas of peach and raspberry.

Winemaker's Notes:

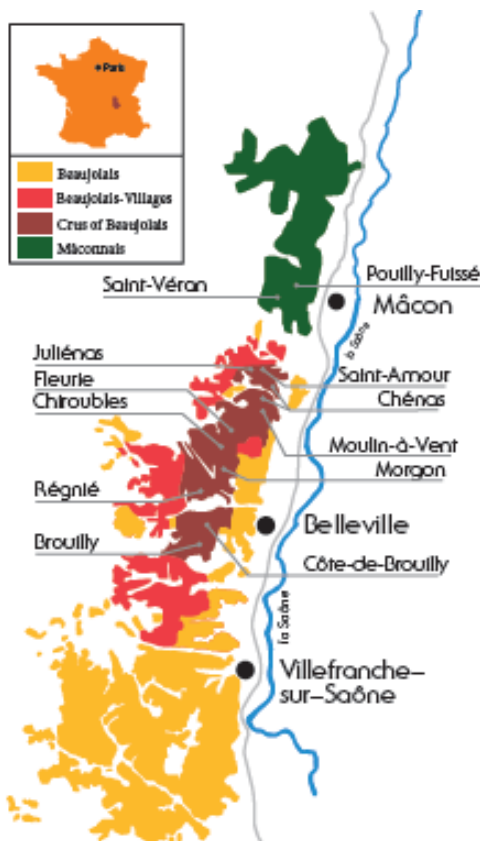
Saint-Amour has a seductive silky finish and notes of peach on the palate. Harvest is conducted manually, in whole bunches fermented with indigenous yeasts.

Serving Hints:

This wine is a great match for rich foods, such as filet mignon, beef bourguignon and aged, hard cheeses.

Interesting Facts:

Saint-Amour is the northernmost Beaujolais Cru, and the smallest. The vineyards are planted on granite pebbles, which prove to produce wines that are powerful and full-bodied.
