After a short time working with Citibank, NA (from 2000 to 2002) and living during that period in New York City, Arturo returned to his native Chile to run the export department for the famed Chilean winery, Vina Undurraga. Among his duties was the creation and operation of the winery's North American offices to import Undurraga wines directly to the Untied States.

In 2007, the Undurraga family sold the winery, vineyards and family label to a Chilean banking consortium, at which time Arturo left for his current position with Matetic Vineyards. As General Manager, his main focus is to position Matetic's fine wines from Chile's San Antonio Valley (using certified organic grapes) as the "benchmark" for top-quality Chilean Sauvingon Blanc, Syrah and Pinot Noir and other "cool climate" grapes.
