Particular Bianchi was created as a super premium, varietal specific wines are noted by power, strength and complexity. The wines are hand-harvested and sorted and aged for 14 months in 100% new oak (French and American) and an additional 12 months in the bottle prior to release.

Particular wines will seduce even the most demanding palates.

Famiglia Bianchi

Famiglia Bianchi is a premium line of varietal specific wines made to showcase the best characteristic of each varietal and express the true terroir of the region. The grapes are hand-harvested and sorted and aged for 10 months in 100% new oak (French and American) with an additional 10 months in the bottle prior to release.
