"Blueberries, plums and currants with some dried herbs, too, on the nose. It's medium- to full-bodied with firm tannins. Good fruit with a soft character and delicate texture. Juicy and playful. Drink now."

"This is a well-structured red that has depth and nice acidity. The nose is aromatic, offering leather, spices and raspberries followed by notes of smoke. A firm structure holds the palate. Tart cherry, plum, hints of paprika, black pepper, cinnamon and smoke lead to a flavorful finish. Drink now through 2031."

"Lovely oak spice, licorice, rooibos, black currant leaf, boysenberry and blackberry preserves all form the nose of this deep, layered wine. It's medium-plus in weight, with a texture like crushed velvet, thanks to plush yet structuring tannins and ample black-fruit flavors. It's well-balanced and hard to resist, though it should mature well through 2029."

"Perfumed nose of blueberries, spiced plums, chocolate orange, sweet spices and burnt hazelnuts. Medium-to full-bodied with chalky tannins and a spicy, flavorful palate. Sustainable. Vegan. Drink or hold."
