"Deep garnet-purple in color, the 2011 The Redwind Shiraz flaunts a gorgeous nose of creme de cassis, Black Forest cake and dried lavender with suggestions of dusty earth and Szechuan pepper. Full-bodied and richly fruited in the mouth, it offers a great expression and harmony at this youthful stage with medium to firm, velvety tannins and balanced acidity supporting the black fruit liqueur flavors. It finishes with excellent length."

"Part of the Scarce Earth project which celebrates the region's best Shiraz vineyards, the fruit for this wine was sourced from a single block within the Shirvington Redwind vineyard. Very deep purple-black in color, the 2010 The Redwind Shiraz is a little closed on the nose at first but with coaxing it reveals notes of blackberry pie and Chinese dried plums and blackcurrant cordial with hints of incense, dried fruit cake, licorice and mocha. Very full-bodied and densely packed with blackberry preserve and spiced prune flavors it has a crisp acid line to enliven and medium to firm velvety tannins, finishing long."
