

2020

"A firm and silky red with cherry, berry and some cedar character. Medium body. Slightly chewy on the finish. But solid. Give it a year or two to soften. Try after 2022."

2019

• 93 Pts. – James Suckling, April 23, 2021

"Strawberry, pink grapefruit, pomegranate and hibiscus on the nose. Red tea and clove, too. It's medium-bodied with round, sleek tannins and fresh acidity. Some mineral undertones on the finish."

• 90 Pts. Wine Advocate, May 6, 2021

"Aromas of mulberries, blackcurrants, cinnamon and rose petal...a medium-bodied, supple wine with a pretty core of fruit, fine-boned structure and good length on the finish. This is a good effort from Duboeuf."

• 94 Pts. - James Suckling, Nov. 13, 2019

"What a beautiful red with extremely perfumed aromas of blackberries, blueberries, cherries, flowers and tile. Medium to full body, round and lightly chewy tannins and a tangy and fruity finish. Drink or hold."

• 92 Pts. – Vinous, Oct. 2019

"Bright purple. Vibrant, spice-tinged aromas of fresh dark berries, violet and peppery spices, along with a smoky nuance that builds in the glass. Offers black raspberry, bitter cherry and floral pastille flavors that show very good depth while a spine of juicy acidity adds lift and focus. Nicely focused and gently sweet on the subtly tannic finish, which clings with strong, floral-tinged tenacity."

2017

• 93 Pts. - James Suckling, Dec. 21, 2018

"An opulent and juicy red with dark berries and undertones of earth and walnuts, following through to a medium body, soft and silky tannins and a beautiful finish. Lovely length to this. Drink or hold."

• 91 Pts. - Wine & Spirits, April 2019

"Gérard Charvet makes this wine at his family's domaine; it's bottled by Duboeuf. Packed with earthy tannins, this is a mineral-driven Moulin-à-Vent with brisk strawberry notes washing over the cool earth tones. It has the structure to benefit from a year or two of bottle age."

• 90 Pts. – Wine Enthusiast, March 2019

"Partially aged in wood, this smoothly textured, dense wine is packed with black fruits, bright acidity and spice. The fresh edge contrasts with the dry tannins that will soften as the wine develops. Give this wine until 2020 before drinking."
