

"Brilliant violet color. Primary black/blue fruit aromas, along with suggestions of pungent flowers and cracked pepper. Sappy, spice-laced boysenberry and bitter cherry flavors become sweeter and deeper with air. Rich but lively in style, finishing very long and juicy, showing repeating floral character and smooth, harmonious tannins adding gentle grip."

"Very aromatic with smoky notes, as well as wet earth and juicy berries, following through to a full body, tight and linear palate and a long finish. More like a Cote d'Or red in structure. Give it a year or two to come together. Try it in 2019."

2016

"Quite bright and upbeat with the red fruits on the nose, all of which leads to a palate with some assertive and sinewy tannins. Drink now."

Vivid ruby. Powerful cherry and black raspberry aromas, complicated by floral and smoky mineral nuances. Juicy black raspberry and bitter cherry flavors offer an appealing blend of richness and vivacity and turn sweeter with air. Smoky and penetrating on the finish, which shows excellent clarity and strong, floral- and mineral-tinged persistence.

"One of two wines named after a legendary vine grower in Morgon, this wine has weight and great tannins. Structured, ripe black fruits are generous and developing well. The boisterous fruit needs to calm down a little, so drink this wine from late 2018."
