"This is very perfumed with aromas of cherries and hints of citrus. Medium body, fine tannins and fresh finish. Delicate at the end. Drink now."

"Fragrant aromas of ripe strawberry, watermelon, hibiscus, lemon zest, and wet soil. It's medium-bodied with fine, silky tannins and tangy acidity."

"A linear and juicy red with plenty of plummy fruit and flowers that follow through to a medium body. Delicious finish. Drink now."

"This has a very seamless feel of roses and violet florals. A fresh, lithe and gently tannic palate that delivers a long, fluid finish. Drink now."
