“This is spiced and cedary with ripe berry character and hints of ground cloves and nutmeg. Medium- to full-bodied with fine, slightly chewy tannins, chalky texture and notes of cigar box in the finish. Drink now.”

2021

- 91 – TASTING PANEL, *May 2024 Issue*

“Made with Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, this wine is from Alentejano, which is known as “land of the cork.” A mix of earth, spice, and black fruit aromas such as black currant, raisin, licorice, coffee, vanilla, and tobacco are savory. On the palate, the taste of black fruit – especially cassis – is predominant, along with hints of clove, green pepper, mint, cocoa, and caramel. This full-bodied wine has a rich mouthfeel.”

“The cork label of this rich, smooth wine is a reminder that Alentejo's vines are interspersed with the trees that provide much of the world's cork. The wine has a rich southern character, soft tannins and plenty of blackberry fruits. It is ready to drink..”

“The cork label is a reminder that the Alentejo is where most of Portugal's cork oaks grow. The wine is southern in feel, warm and ripe, with generous fruitiness from the Alicante Bouschet in the blend. Red berry fruits are laced with acidity and fine soft tannins. Drink from 2017.”
