# • 94 – JAMES SUCKLING, February 16, 2022

"Blackberries and blueberries with lots of coffee and lightly toasted oak. Opulent aromas to say the least. Fullbodied with round tannins and a juicy finish. 60% malbec, 30% cabernet sauvignon and 10% syrah. Give this three or four years to come around. Try after 2024."

# • 95 – VINOUS, November 30, 2021

"...Dark purple in the glass. The complex nose offers notes of ripe plum and blueberry along with an elegant licorice liqueur that enhances the chocolatey cedar and white pepper aromas from the aging process. In the mouth, it's rich and expansive with good volume and a tacky flow. The tannins are ripe and velvety thanks to the barrel aging. Delivering a precisely calibrated balance between power ripeness, this is one for the cellar."

### • 93 – WINE ADVOCATE, April 2020

" A selection of 26 barrels made by Californian winemaker Paul Hobbs, this Magdalena Toso is a blend of 67% Malbec and 33% Cabernet Sauvignon. It has a ripe and hedonistic profile. It is aged in French Oak for 18 months."

# • 97 – DECANTER, 2020 World Wine Awards: Platinum

"Stunning cassis, fruit cake, cacao and gentle vanilla aromas. On the palate, it is intense, with ripe black fruit, restrained spice and well-integrated oak; overall length and balance can't be faulted. Very impressive.

#### • 93 - WINE SPECTATOR, November 2019

"Fleshy, powerful and full of unctuous dried blueberry, blackberry and plum tart flavors that are interwoven with notes of cocoa powder and savory spice. Sanguine elements emerge midpalate, leading to a long finish that lingers with hints of freshly ground white pepper."

#### • 93 – VINOUS, September 2019

"Bright ruby. Sexy graphite oak (New French), black raspberry, violet, species and cocoa nibs on the nose. Plush, deep and fine-grained, with a touch of sweetness and good mineral lift to the rich dark berry, spice and violet flavors. Offers a lovely combination of density, definition and lift. Finishes very suave and long, with noble tannins, a sneaky whiplash of dark fruits and dark chocolate, and no rough edges..."

# • 92 – JAMES SUCKLING, April 2020

"Fine, toasty oak adds lots of roasted spice to the black and blue fruit and cedar tone. Full-bodied, but with transparent tension and an ethereal feel in the middle. Juicy and spicy, this certainly is not lacking in mid-palate definition. Very long. A blend of 73% malbec and 27% cabernet sauvignon. Drinkable now, but better after 2021."
