"Deep and expressive nose with a drizzle of black pepper and violet on top of fresh blackberries. Juicy, medium-bodied on the palate with some tight yet silky tannins rounding it off to a fruit-oriented medium-length finish. Enjoy now."

"Dark berries and fresh flowers, such as violets, follow through to a medium body with fine tannins and a delicious finish. Just a hint of chocolate and walnut at the end. Drink now."

"This wine makes a grand entrance, bugles and all. The wine spends a year in new oak, (80 percent American) and yet that oak feels judicious, framing blueberry, blackberry and sun-ripened cassis within earthy dark chocolate and spice. For anything hearty, whether that's Costa Rican casado or salt-and-pepper steak."

"A medium-to full-bodied red with aromas of blackberry, black cherry, sandalwood and clove. Firm, creamy tannins frame a rich core of dark fruit. Fresh finish. Drink now."
