The ripe aftertaste will grow more velvety in the bottle."

"The liqueur-style nose features plum, blackberry jam and spices along with hints of cassis, followed by secondary but attractive notes of oak and cedar. Intense and full of flavor, with juicy tannins that lend a finely grained texture, it also presents a slightly dusty sensation, making for a rewarding contrast. Concentrated on the vine, the back of the mouth is spicy and lasts for a very long time. A Napa-style wine."
