“I tasted two vintages of their eponymous and flagship Syrah, so I was able to compare the 2015 Syrah to the previous 2014 vintage. 2015 was a warm and dry year, and it resulted in a rounder and softer palate. But don't get me wrong, this is a serious Syrah with good freshness and balance, darker fruit, sweeter tannins and softer spiciness. This is a more approachable and juicier version of their top bottling. It's already polished and ready but should keep nicely in bottle.”
